HOW TO REACH US FROM GRANADA'S AIRPORT

Buses to and from Granada's airport are scheduled according to flights arrivals and departures. That means that theoretically at least there should always be a bus waiting for passengers whenever a flight arrives. Buses usually wait long enough before they depart to make sure all the passengers have time to collect their luggage, leave the terminal and make it to the bus. The bus from the airport costs only 3 Euros and it will drop you off just 1 block from Granada B&B Homestay's front door which makes it very convenient. Tell the driver you want to get off at the "Jardines del Triunfo" bus stop, which is in on Gran Via Street, in front of "Delegación de Gobierno" a beautiful building know by locals as "La Normal". By doing so, the bus will actually pass in front of our front door. Unfortunately the bus will not stop here.

When you get off the bus, ahead of you, on the same direction the bus goes, is Gran Via. Note the "stylist" and controversial geometric street lamps made out of many cubes. You don't want to go that way! Not now! Instead, undo the path, and go back the way the bus came from towards Avenida de Constitucion. Stay on the left side of the street all the time. A huge Spanish flag in the middle of a roundabout is the first thing you will see. It is so big; if the wind is blowing it will be the ONLY thing you will see. Go around it -always on your left- and cross San Juan de Dios, an interesting old commercial street with lots of nice buildings, monuments and churches to visit. I'll tell you about it when you are here. Cross Santa Barbara Street -you won't actually see the street but a little square with some steps on its left leading to the street below- and keep going. Pass Domino's Pizza and a Hairdresser (Santiagodelrio) before arriving at our front door at number 11 which is just before a shoe-shop.

Note that only buildings have numbers. Shops and restaurants do not. Don't be surprised then if number 11 is not right after number 9 or before number 13 as the shops in between do not have numbers.

When you get here look for the bell on the building's front door labeled "4D" (that means 4th floor, door D) Ring the bell so that we can open the front door for you. Take the elevator and go up to the 4th floor. Our door displays a blue and white B&B sign. Note we don't have any sign outside in the street.
